Meeting Summary

1. **Call to Order (Belluscio, Teresa)**

Welcome and appreciation to committee members for attending the meeting.

2. **Announcements (Nnoromele, Salome)**

3. **Approve Previous Minutes (Belluscio, Teresa)**

Co-Chair Teresa Belluscio motioned for the minutes of the October 22, 2007 meeting to be approved. The motion was seconded by Wardell Johnson. The minutes were approved with no amendments.

4. **Discuss Campus Climate Survey (Belluscio, Teresa; Nnoromele, Salome; Committee)**

With the survey participants in mind, plausible needs were considered as committee members discussed the following questions:

1. Why is the University asking me to fill out this campus climate survey?
 - *Answers to this survey will assist ECU Administrators, Committees and Special Offices to better equip the campus in meeting our Institutional Goal:*
 - *To promote and support an inclusive climate that respects and celebrates diversity by attracting, developing and educating a diverse student, faculty and staff population.*
2. What is a "climate" survey?
 - *What is diversity?*
3. How long will it take to fill out the survey?
 - *A survey should not go over 15 minutes to complete*
4. Will my survey be anonymous?
 - *The data will be aggregate*
5. Why is my voice important?
6. How can ECU benefit from answers to this survey?
 - *Is there a need to disclose how research data will be used and what information the data will yield?*
7. Is it necessary to reformat the survey to create a more consistent answer scale?
 - *Although Question #30 has the following answer scale: Experienced, Witnessed, Neither--the lead in to the survey states that Questions 1-37 have the following answer scale: Strongly Disagree, Disagree, Agree, Strongly Agree.*
 - *Should the formatting include a directive to ensure that participants provide an answer to #29 if selected either Strongly Disagree or Disagree to #28?*
8. Should the survey be revised to include more elementary terms or alternative vocabulary, or should the survey remain as is with a raised bar? Examples questioned were words such as, "initiatives," and "diverse".
 - *Do students understand what is meant by the term "diversity"?*

9. Can the survey be absolute, especially with regard to participants' individual views, perceptions, etc.?
 - *We might wish to consider a detailed follow-up survey concerning derogatory comments; participation; experience.*
10. Campus Climate Survey Timeline
 - November 2007: finalize questions for survey
 - December 2007: discuss how survey will be disseminated
 - January 2008: finalize plans for dissemination
 - February 2008: first posting
 - March 2008: second posting
 - April 2008: results – initial report
 - May 2008: discussion of results and implications; report to the President Whitlock
